FOOD BOX GIVEAWAY PROGRAM

The Food Box Giveaway Program works by buying fresh & healthy food from local farms at a fair price and distributing the food free of charge in low-income, rural, and underserved communities including food deserts. In 2025, CMI reached for the first time WV's Northern Panhandle & the coal fields in southern WV.

LOCAL FOOD ACCESS PROGRAM

The Local Food Access Program makes healthy & affordable groceries sourced from local producers available for West Virginian communities, especially food deserts & low-income communities. Two key infrastructure components that help link farm fresh food to families are: 1) CMI's mobile cold storage trailers & 2) eCommerce websites which allow customers to place pre-orders for convenient pick up at the mobile markets. Currently two markets are part of the Program: St. Isidore Market in Charles Town & Magnolia Market in Paw Paw.

SENIOR VOUCHER PROGRAM

200 seniors received \$50 in grocery vouchers to use at CMI's mobile markets. Magnolia Market in Paw Paw saw an 87% redemption rate with a 75% overall redemption rate across both Markets. Funding for the program came from the Eastern West Virginia Community Foundation.

LOCAL FOOD BACKPACK PROGRAM

500 Jefferson County Schools K-12 students received a backpack full of sharable fresh & healthy groceries from local farms on three separate occasions during the Winter/Spring semester. Kilmer's Farm Market & Jefferson County Schools were critical partners in this program's success.

SNAP EXTEND FUND

SNAP EBT users can double their SNAP benefits by shopping at CMI's mobile farmers markets. SNAP Extend Funds are issued at check out and can be used immediately to purchase double the amount of fresh & healthy groceries from local farmers. Over \$1,300 of SNAP Funds were redeemed or issued in 2025.

RESELLER PROGRAM

Food Pantries, Grocery & Convenience Stores, and Restaurants can buy hundreds of food products from local farms through CMI well below retail prices, keeping input costs down while providing high-quality food to clients and supporting CMI's mission. THERE'S A LOT TO BE GRATEFUL FOR AT COMMUNITY MARKETS, INC!

- Doubled the Food Box Giveaway Program to twice a month.
- Piloted Magnolia Market in Paw Paw, WV.
- Began our SNAP Extend Fund.
- Doubled the Senior Voucher Program with a 75% redemption rate.
- Moved the CMI office to Shepherdstown, WV, renting 1,000 sq. ft.
- Hired Maria Resendiz as Development Manager & Shannon Griffin as Program Manager.
- Sent over 10,000 lbs. of fresh & local disaster response food to feed thousands of flood victims in Ohio County.
- Established the Judith A. de Leon Emergency Food Memorial Fund.
- Grew the St. Isidore Market with additional Vendors and a new eCommerce website.
- Held the first Food Box Giveaway in the coal fields of southern West Virginia.
- Reached Boone and Ohio Counties, bringing total number of counties served to 12.
- Secured enough funding for a new pick up truck to be purchased soon.


